Provides maintenance and repairs to Community Living Toronto's properties in compliance with health or safety standards.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under the direction of the Supervisor of Properties, this position is responsible for:

- Carpentry; changing locks and doors, repairing floors and replacing tiles, building and replacing smaller partitions, replacing tiles on ceilings, repairing patios, fences, replacing windows and screens, adjusting doors and closers, oil locks and hinges.
- Repairing, plastering, replacing dry-wall and painting.
- Plumbing; repairing and replacing tap washers, repairing and replacing faucets, unclogging drains.
- Electrical; repairing and replacing light switches, changing light fixtures. Minor appliance service and repairs, i.e. washers and dryers, stoves, fridges and air conditioners, minor electrical installation.
