This includes development, implementation, evaluation and support of behavioural strategies for children and adults. The Consultant ensures that Behavioural Support Plans are developed in accordance with the legislated requirements of the Quality Assurance Measures. The Consultant liaises with outside agencies and professionals.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Reporting to the Program Manager, this position :

- Works collaboratively with and maintains regular contact with staff, families and individuals in service to ensure support and success of behaviour strategies.
- Manages new referrals and waiting lists.
- Conducts behavioural assessments.
- Develops Behavioural Support Plans to meet individual needs.
- Works with teams/families to teach, develop, implement and evaluate support plans for individuals.
- Acts as a resource to other professionals in the area of Behaviour Support.
- Participates as a member of the clinical team.
- Identifies gaps in clinical supports.
- Assists with relevant areas of staff training as required.
- Participates as a member of the internal Behavioural Services group.
- As required, participates on internal/ external committees.
- Pursues professional development in the area of behavioural strategies.
