Under the supervision of a program manager, this position is responsible for

- All aspects of group home programs including resident programming and contact, staff performance and scheduling, budgets, routine housekeeping, follow-up re: property maintenance.
- Interviews and hires all group home staff. Carries out regular program reviews.
- Provides ongoing training and evaluation of all staff in the residences.
