Performs maintenance work on Community Living's residences, offices and ancillary locations through and ability to work independently to: assess building and equipment problems, determine or recommend solutions to Supervisor and obtain appropriate materials and/or effect general repairs or adjustments as appropriate.

RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under the direction of the Maintenance Supervisor, this position is responsible for:

- Covering area of Metro assigned by the Maintenance Supervisor or Properties.
- Carefully observing rules and regulations for entering and leaving Community Living Toronto premises.
- Ensuring codes of conduct and ethics maintained re: residents.
- Warning program Supervisors of all proposed visits.
- Providing day to day maintenance and repairs to Community Living Toronto properties.
- Carrying out preventative maintenance of properties, as allocated by Supervisor.
- Observing, reporting and recommending needs of buildings and/or grounds maintenance to Supervisor.
- Moving furniture, etc. in a specific site or location to location when required.
